BYLAW NO. 99-778 OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMISSION.

WHEREAS the Town of Two Hills wishes to participate in the establishment of a regional solid waste management commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the Municipal Government Act (S.A. 1994, c. M-26.1 as amended);

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Two Hills, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1

SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "Solid Waste Management Commission Authorization Bylaw" of the Town of Two Hills.

SECTION 2

REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT COMMISSION

2.1 The Council of the Town of Two Hills is hereby authorized to make any necessary Agreements and take the necessary action together with the Council of any other Municipality or Municipalities for the establishment of a regional solid waste management commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the Municipal Government Act.
