DELEGATION: Cpl. James Morton, Two Hills RCMP Detachment

Cpl. Morton requested an opportunity to discuss with Council his intention of redeveloping the Joint Municipal Policing Committee (JMPC). In the past the JMPC was composed of Chief Elected Officials within the region and the Sergeant of the local detachment that met quarterly. The revived committee would meet quarterly and the main objective to better address the issues or needs of the community. Further to the discussion Cpl. J. Morton wants to include community representatives and youth participation to try to gain different perspectives to understanding the various needs of Two Hills and work towards making our community a safe community.

Cpl. Morton is hoping to have the first meeting sometime in the first part of March. He also suggested public meetings in order to generate ideas and

engage discussion. There may be some grants available for community crime prevention programs. The County of Two Hills and Village of Myrnam are drafting a letter to meet for the first time.

Council was very much in favor of supporting Cpl. Morton's endeavor in ensuring a safe community for our residents. Mayor H. Neufeld, on behalf of Council, provided Cpl. Morton the Town of Two Hills support in reviving the JMPC.

OPEN FORUM:

One member of the public expressed his concern over receiving a utility bill in the excess of \$30,000.00. The resident said he had not gone to the Administration Office to inquire of its legitimacy. Council advised the resident to visit the Administration Office for more information.

Public Works Report

A request for a \$100,000.00 advance towards the construction was received from Dr. Satar in order for the building to continue. With this motion the Town has contributed \$300,000 out of \$400,000. The final quarter payment of public funds will be advanced very carefully.
