Review of Previous Minutes

Administration:

✓ Replaced 3 laptops (2 Administration Office, 1 Public Works)

Fire Protection:

✓ Contribution to new Rapid Fund (\$5,000 per year)









Roads/Sidewalks:

- ✓ Lease on Skidsteer
- ✓ Dump Truck (loan)
- ✓ Continue repairing potholes and excavations from water and sewer breaks with hot mix and/or cold mix where there is old pavement.
- √ \$100,000 worth of sidewalks replaced or repaired throughout the Town
 where needed most.







Roads/Sidewalks (cont'd):

- ✓ SB90 on two cul-de-sacs, in front of the Senior Centre, and 49 Street north of 50 Avenue.
- Avenue between 49 & 50 Street, north of 50 Avenue between 50 & 51 Street, east of 50 Street between 49 & 50 Street, north and west side of Lodge, north of 51 Avenue between 46 & 48 Street, north of 50 A Avenue between 46 & 44 Street, west of 45 Street from 50 A Avenue between 46 & 43 Street, north of 47 Avenue starting at address 4822 to 47 Street.







Water/Wastewater:

- ✓ Installed a sewerline from the Geleta Park washrooms to the main sewerline on 45 Avenue; eliminated many hours, including overtime, using the vac truck.
- ✓ Replaced waterline under Highway 36 between 47 52 Avenue.









Recreation:

✓ New Recreational / Curling Rink Facility – under construction.

Other:

- ✓ Surveillance Cameras in Geleta Park and at Water Reservoir
- ✓ New Medical Facility
- ✓ Replace exhaust system in hall in progress
- ✓ Fencing with gates in Geleta Park
- ✓ Rehabilitation of town bleachers









Also to note:

Other organizations, particularly the Sports Activity Council and the Geleta Park Committee, have made significant improvements to Geleta Park by way of completing the new ball diamonds, putting up a concession booth and improving the rest of the bleachers.
