

BYLAW NO. 2011-903 OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REPEAL CERTAIN BYLAWS

Whereas, pursuant to *Municipal Government Act*, a Council may pass bylaws for the purpose of repealing bylaws that are inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective;

And Whereas the Town of Two Hills finds it necessary to repeal inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent and ineffective bylaws to promote an efficient Administration department;

Now Therefore by the virtue of the power conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, the Council for the Town of Two Hills enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

This bylaw shall be cited as "Repeal Bylaw 2003-812"

2. BYLAW TO BE REPEALED

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of third and final reading.
